Highlights

North Central (IL) edges out Central (IA) for second consecutive crown: Winning a national title is the result of a combined effort by both the student-athletes and the coaches, as evident at the 2011 NCAA Division III Men's Track and Field Championships hosted by Capital University.

The North Central (Illinois) men had just one individual national title. But it was their supporting cast that led to a greater reward -- team success.

The Cardinals' Mike Spain, in the 5,000-meter run, was their lone national champion, as he shattered the facility record by 22 seconds en route to the title in 14:17.42. However, it was a balanced team effort that led to a national team title.

In addition to Spain's 10 points, the North Central championship effort was supported by three scorers in the pole vault, two more scorers in the 400-meter dash, and one individual each in the weight throw and in the high jump for their third national title and second straight. The balance paid off in the one-point victory for the championship as North Central edged Central (Iowa), 45-44, for the win.

The Cardinals rallied from a 20-point deficit, and in the end, three points separated first from fourth place. Wisconsin-La Crosse was third with 43 points, while Wisconsin-Oshkosh was fourth with 42 points. North Central has now won eight national titles in track and field (three indoor, five outdoor).

"It was a great team effort. We weren't leading from day one like last year. We were behind and had to keep picking away at it," said head coach Frank Gramarosso.

Spain was sitting in third, before making a move with a mile to go and eventually winning the race by a comfortable four-second margin.

"Coming in here, it was a lot easier with the whole team behind us," Spain said. "I tried to run a conservative race and then push the second half when I felt I could move to the finish. You can't let times and numbers get in our heads. We try and focus on how we feel and intuition and feel the race. Every race is different. The accolades are nice, but it's really what I learned along the way and the fact that I can be here with my teammates that are the great parts."

Four-thousandths of a second separated Daniel Benton from claiming the national title in the 400-meter dash after winning the first of two heats to earn All-America accolades. Benton surged ahead of the field right after the cut-in and held off a late charge from Neumann's Brandon Bennett-Green to win heat one in 48.27. Buffalo State's Justin Allen claimed heat two, also clocking a 48.27, but edging Benton by four-thousandths of a second for the national title.

Jon Howard finished third in his heat and fifth overall in the 400, clocking a 48.93 and earning All-America honors in the process.

Matt Borchardt opened up the final of competition with a 12th-place finish in the pentathlon, scoring 3,079 points.

Robert Kapustka, competing in his second event in as many days, finished ninth in the shot put with a throw of 51 feet 1/4 inch. Kapustka advanced to finals with a toss of 50 feet 8 inches before recording his best mark on his second attempt in the championship flight.

The Cardinals tallied five All-Americans after day one of competition. Peter Geraghty was second in the pole vault, while Thomas Stacey and Josh Winder were fourth and seventh, respectively. Kapustka was third in the weight throw, while Zachariah Heerspink finished sixth in the high jump.

"We've been doing the same thing for years, it's all about the process. They went out there and did the best they can do. It's a great coaching staff with a lot of head coaches in each event area. We're just trying to do what we've been doing in the 28 years I've been in the program," Gramarosso said.
