Highlights

Wartburg scores 99 points to win third title in four years: After losing its two-year stranglehold on the NCAA Division III women's indoor track and field crown last season, Wartburg reclaimed the coveted trophy in 2012.

The Knights piled up 99 points to easily win the meet, which concluded March 10 at Grinnell's Charles Benson Bear '39 Recreation and Athletic Center Field House. Wisconsin-Oshkosh, which won the 2011 title, was a distant second with 48 points and Washington U. in St. Louis took third with 30.

Wartburg won three events the final day, including the 1,600-meter relay to finish the meet. Skye Morrison, Faith Burt, Kendra Kregel and Nevada Morrison teamed to win the race in 3:45.66. Nevada Morrison added a win in the 400-meter dash in 55.80 seconds, while Laura Sigmund took first in the 5,000-meter run with a time of 17:01.82.

Skye Morrison also claimed an individual title on the meet's first day, winning the long jump with a championships-record effort of 20 feet, 3 inches. Morrison, who won the long jump in 2010, also placed third in the 400 and fourth in the triple jump in 2012.

Christy Cazzola of Wisconsin-Oshkosh was a double winner by claiming the 800-meter and mile runs in 2:13.40 and 4:51.99, respectively. Rose-Hulman's Elizabeth Evans (high jump) and Ithaca's Emma Dewart (pentathlon) successfully defended their 2011 titles.

The 2012 meet marked the first time that Division III contested the shorter dash and the hurdles event at 60 meters, up from the 55-meter distance used since the championships' inception in 1985. Methodist's Ashlynn Chavis won the inaugural 60-meter dash (7.54 seconds) and Birmingham-Southern's Tiarra Goode the 60-meter hurdles (8.56).
