Highlights

Academy of Art's inaugural appearance is a winner: In its first year of postseason eligibility, Academy of Art won the 2013 Division II Women's Indoor Track and Field Championships team title March 7 to 9 at the Birmingham Crossplex in Birmingham, Ala.

The newcomers from San Francisco racked up 59 points during the three-day event, 10½ points better than second-place Lincoln (Missouri) and 18 more than two-time defending champion Grand Valley State (41). On the final day, Urban Knights' senior Vashti Thomas, who took first in the long jump earlier in the meet, won the 200-meter dash and placed fourth in the triple jump, giving her team an insurmountable 12-point lead heading into the final event, the 1,600-meter relay.

"For me, what happened in Birmingham this past week was about two things: these amazing artist-athletes and what their victory stands for in the greater landscape of academics and sports," said Academy of Art head coach Charles Ryan. "Athletes who also have a passion for art until now have always had to make a choice and could never have both.

"You could not be serious about art and be taken seriously as an athlete. Well, that message is dead."

Academy of Art showed its depth in the 60-meter hurdles, placing four in the final field. While Johnson C. Smith's Danielle Williams finished first in 8.08 seconds, four Knights earned team points, led by Thomas in second place (8.16), Briana Stewart in third, Julian Purvis in fifth, and Dinesha Bean in seventh.

The champions were one of four schools to win two events each. Latoya King of runner-up Lincoln won the 60-meter dash in 7:38 seconds, and the Tigers also captured the 1,600 relay. Grand Valley State's Sam Lockhart won the shot put and weight throw. Melissa Agnew of Mary won the mile run in 4:46.94, and was part of the winning distance medley relay team that finished in 11:28.92.

Lockhart's winning toss of 69 feet, ¾ inch in the weight throw was also the only meet record, improving on her 2012 mark of 67 feet, 6 inches. Michelle Cumberbatch was a member of Lincoln's victorious 1,600-meter relay team for the fourth consecutive year.
