Highlights

Five gold medals lead Wisconsin-Oshkosh to eighth title: Christy Cazzola contributed three of Wisconsin-Oshkosh's five victories, as the Titans won the 2013 NCAA Division III Women's Indoor Track and Field Championships team title March 8 and 9 at North Central (Illinois).

Wisconsin-Oshkosh, which set a championships record with the five first places, easily took the title with 56 points. Illinois College placed second with 32, followed by Wisconsin-La Crosse with 27, Wartburg with 25 and Monmouth (Illinois) with 24. It is the Titans' division-leading eighth indoor crown.

In a span of two hours, Cazzola won both the mile and 5,000-meter runs. She clocked a time of 4:48.11 to take the mile for the second year in a row.

Cazzola then faced a large deficit with one lap remaining in the 5,000-meter race. She erased the gap and crossed the line in 16:57.58 to defeat Calvin's Nicole Michmerhuizen by 0.09 seconds.

The Titans' distance medley relay unit of Cazzola, Stephanie Jahn, McKenzie Kelly and Kylee Verhasselt clocked 11:32.24 to set a new meet record. In the weight throw, Samantha Loew earned gold with her toss of 62 feet, ¼ inch. Melanie Brickner finished third for the Titans in that event.

Breanna Strupp also was a champion for Wisconsin-Oshkosh. After finishing fourth in the shot put in 2012, Strupp outdistanced the rest of the field by nearly two feet to earn first place.

Melissa Norville lifted Illinois College to its runner-up finish by winning the 60-meter hurdles, long jump and triple jump. Her time of 8.52 seconds in the hurdles was a meet record.

Mount Union's Mary Mahoney also established a new mark in the 400-meter dash with her winning time of 55.21 seconds.
