Highlights

Grand Valley State reigns supreme; Lincoln (Missouri) gets eighth top-two finish in past nine seasons: Grand Valley State won its first NCAA Division II Women's Outdoor Track and Field Championships team title in dominating fashion at Al Brenda Track on the campus of Cal State Stanislaus May 26 to 28. The Lakers logged 10 All-America performances on the final day in windy and rainy conditions, outdistancing runner-up Lincoln (Missouri), 82½-68.

In doing so, Grand Valley State completed a cycle of sorts, having also won the NCAA Division II Women's Cross Country Championships and Division II Indoor Track and Field Championships in 2010-11.

"One thing we pride ourselves on is having a well-rounded program," said Grand Valley State head coach Jerry Baltes. "We came out and battled today. The conditions weren't great, a couple of our top girls didn't do as well as we expected, but we had some [other] girls step up."

Adams State finished third with 51 points, Johnson C. Smith was fourth with 36, and UC San Diego came in fifth with 35. Central Missouri and Western Washington (29½ points each), Western State (28), New Haven (24) and Augustana (South Dakota) (23) rounded out the top 10.

Grand Valley State was led by individual champions Lauren Buresh in the shot put and Liz Murphy in the hammer throw. The Lakers also scored 19 points in the 1,500-meter run, thanks to the second-, third- and fourth-place finishes of Monica Kinney, Katherine McCarthy, and Eileen Creutz, respectively.

Lincoln, which has finished among the top two teams in eight of the last nine seasons, received wins from Judith Riley in the 100-meter dash and Yanique Haye in the 400-meter hurdles and also claimed the 400-meter relay.

Shannon Gagne of New Haven was the 200- and 400-meter dashes champion. Concord's Shawnee Carnett won the 800-meter run. Runa Falch of Augustana won the 1,500-meter run title. Neely Spence of Shippensburg was the 5,000-meter run champ. Johnson C. Smith's Shermaine Williams won the 100-meter hurdles. And the Cal State Dominguez Hills 1,600-meter relay team of Breionna Jackson, Dora Baldwin, Chanel Parker and Nancy Blake gave that school its first track national title.
