Highlights

Wisconsin-Oshkosh wins ninth national title; dominate throwing events en route to championship: In 2010, Wisconsin-Oshkosh walked off the track draped in disappointment. The Titans had lost out on the national championship by a single point to Illinois Wesleyan.

Wisconsin-Oshkosh didn't leave any room for a close call at the 2011 NCAA Division III Women's Track and Field Championships May 26 to 28 at Selby Stadium in Delaware, Ohio, scoring 80 points to beat runner-up Wartburg (59) and put the exclamation on the program's ninth title.

The Titans came into the meet ranked No. 1 in the country and had no problem living up to the hype.

"When I was doing the meet on paper, there was no way I thought we would win by 21 points," Titans head coach Pat Ebel said. "It's a great accomplishment and I am excited for our team. It's a great feeling to win a national title."

The Titans had four individual champions, which played a pivotal role in leading them to a national title for the first time since 2007. Christy Cazzola ran 4:22.11 in the 1,500-meter run and was the only champion for Wisconsin-Oshkosh in a running event.

"I just wanted to get in a good position to start out and just get in with a pack and then start moving up in position around that 800-meter mark, which I did," Cazzola said. "And then at the 400-meter mark, I just gave everything I had and held on until the end."

Jecel Gerner threw the shot put 49-feet, 7-inches to win the title and teammate Holly Ozanich was second with a toss of 48-7. Ozanich would end up with her own title, however, placing first in the hammer throw with a throw of 200 feet.

The other champion was Brianna Strupp in the discus. She came through with a throw of 160-5.

"We had unbelievable performances by those athletes," Ebel said. "Everyone performed at the level I expected them to. They all peaked at the right time and gave great efforts."

It is really no surprise that Oshkosh ended the season on top of the track world. This title was something the Titans had been gunning for since the fall when they set goals for the season.

"Losing last year definitely motivated the team," Ebel said. "They worked hard in the off season to get ready and this was one of their goals for the year. To see them accomplish it is amazing. Their hard work paid off."

Ashlynn Chavis of Methodist won the 100-meter dash, crossing the line in 11.84 seconds. She was also the long jump champion and helped the Monarchs' 400-meter relay team win a national title.

Chavis' teammate, Ruby Blackwell, won the 200-meter dash with a time of 24.19. Their efforts helped Methodist finish third with 48 points.

Nevada Morrison of Wartburg took first in the 400, coming through with a time of 54.74 seconds. Coe's Keelie Finnel was first in the 800 (2:08.48).

Jennifer Gossels of Williams ran to titles in the 5,000- and 10,000-meter runs. She won the 5,000 with a time of 17:06.76 and the 10,000 with a time of 35:11.67.

George Fox standout Irene Johnson won the 100-meter hurdles in a time of 14.51 seconds and Stevens's Laura Barito won the 400 hurdles at 59.49.

Kimberly Chain of Baldwin-Wallace was the champ in the 3,000-meter steeplechase (10:24.22) and Elizabeth Evans of Rose-Hulman captured the high jump with a leap of 5-8.

Moravian's Abigail Schaffer was first in the pole vault (13-7) and Williams' Tanasia Hoffer was the triple jump champion (40-5). Other national champions included Carleton's Kelly Lovett in the javelin (155-4) and Janey Helland of Gustavus Adolphus in the heptathlon (5,061 points).
