### Highlights

**Wisconsin-La Crosse holds off Wisconsin-Eau Claire to capture 12th outdoor championship** -- The host took the spoils May 25 during the final day of competition for the 2013 NCAA Division III Men's Outdoor Track and Field Championships as Wisconsin-La Crosse triumphed in Roger Harring Stadium at the Veterans Memorial Field Sports Complex by beating runner-up Wisconsin-Eau Claire by two points, 66-64.

It was a breakthrough for Wisconsin-La Crosse, which had finished second the past two Division III outdoor championships to 2011 champion North Central (Illinois) and 2012 champion McMurry.

It is the Eagles' 12th Division III outdoor title and the first since they went back to back in 2006-07.

"All the alums, the friends, the families — this is beyond me," said Wisconsin-La Crosse head coach Josh Buchholtz, as his athletes took the NCAA trophy on an impromptu victory lap around their home stadium.

The top-ranked team entering the national meet, Wisconsin-La Crosse surged ahead on during opening-day events, taking a 26-18 lead ahead of North Central. Not much changed after the second day, except standings tightening at the top. The Eagles stayed out front, but by a much narrower margin — leading North Central by one point 27-26 as Saturday's final-round competition opened.

La Crosse and Eau Claire — Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference rivals — emerged as title contenders as one event final after another was completed on the final afternoon. The 1,600 relay turned out to be a crucial separator; top-seeded Wisconsin-Eau Claire won the event, snaring 10 points, but the Wisconsin-La Crosse relay team kept pace, finishing fourth to earn five points.

Wisconsin-La Crosse senior Isaac Vazquez was a major contributor, winning the long jump title, finishing second in the triple jump and anchoring the 400-meter relay team. The latter was unexpected; he was Buchholtz's choice to replace an injured teammate and did so in the midst of the triple jump competition, which went on hold until he completed his relay duties.

"The guys have been here for four years. They've done this a couple of times," Buchholtz said of finding a way to rack up points. "They know what this is all about."

Saturday's victory gave Wisconsin-La Crosse a sweep of the Division III track and field championships this season as the Eagles won their 16th indoor title in March.

"The indoor was great," Buchholtz said. "It was one of those things I felt a lot easier. We knew we had some control of that one. But this one, the emotions are so much higher. It came down to the wire."

The top four teams in the final outdoor standings — Wisconsin-La Crosse, Wisconsin-Eau Claire, third-place Wisconsin-Oshkosh and fourth-place Wisconsin-Whitewater — attest to WIAC strength in national circles.

"Our conference competitors, you gotta give a hats-off to them," Buchholtz said. "WIAC sweep, one through four, that's impressive. Eau Claire gave us a run for the money right down to the 4x400, (us) knowing what we had to do, then doing it on our home turf."
