# Individual Records

Three-point field goals were added in 1987-88, assists were added in 1988-89 and blocked shots and steals were added in 1992-93. In statistical rankings, the rounding of percentages and/or averages may indicate ties where none exist. In these cases, the numerical order of the rankings is accurate.
