Highlights

Villanova wins second straight: Villanova placed four runners among the top 22 team scorers – including individual champion Sheila Reid – to give the Wildcats a second consecutive team title at the Division I Women's Cross Country Championships on Nov. 22 at the LaVern Gibson Championship Course in Terre Haute, Ind.

Reid, a junior who overcame a severe hip injury early in her career to lead the Wildcats to the last two team titles, capped her comeback by pulling away from the field in the final stretch to win in 20:06.9, more than two seconds ahead of Georgetown's Emily Infeld.

"My last kilometer has been really strong throughout the year, so I knew if it came down to it, I would have enough in the end," Reid said. "I knew by how good I felt coming down the home straight that I would have something left in me."

Her performance helped the Wildcats win their ninth team championship. Villanova also got contributions from senior Amanda Marino (10th overall, eighth among team scorers), senior Alison Smith (24th overall, 20th team) and junior Bogdana Mimic (27th overall, 22nd team).

"We just have such a solid four," said Wildcats coach Gina Procaccio. "That's what we had last year. That was the key."

The Wildcats' title last year ended an 11-year span between crowns.
