Highlights

Middlebury sends out coach with title: Middlebury women's cross country coach Terry Aldrich completed his 36th and final season with style, leading the Panthers to the team title at the 2010 Division III Women's Cross Country Championships on Nov. 20 at Wartburg. Aldrich, who is retiring after having led the school's cross country and skiing programs for almost 40 years, won his sixth NCAA women's cross country title.

"I'm pretty proud of these women," Aldrich said of his team that had been top-ranked all season. "They had a lot of pressure coming in, and for them to do it when they had to, that's impressive."

Middlebury won the title without any top-20 finishers. The Panthers' top three runners were freshman Colette Whitney (40th overall, 24th team), sophomore Addie Tousley (46th overall, 29th team) and junior Margo Cramer (49th overall, 31st team).

St. Lawrence senior Wendy Pavlus was the individual champion for the second year in a row. She outdistanced second-place Jennifer Gossels of Williams by 11.5 seconds but said she was never secure with the lead.

"I don't think there was any point where I really felt like I had it," she said. "Everyone was there (behind me) the whole time – it felt like that, at least. I was scared the whole time."
