Highlights

Washington University in St. Louis blazes with first title, posts lowest national championship score since 2002: Washington University in St. Louis raced to the program's first women's national championship at the 2011 NCAA Division III Cross Country Championships November 19.

"We had great team performances on both sides," Washington head cross country coach Jeff Stiles said. "Our athletes executed the race plan really well and ran with a great deal of confidence. It's fun to get on the awards stand and to win, but the most rewarding thing is to watch the athletes perform well and execute to the best of their abilities. Having your athletes go out and compete the way ours did is all you can ask for as a coach. We had a tremendous following of fans, parents and alums so it was a great atmosphere."

After finishing as the runner-up in 2010, Washington had all five of its point-scorers place in the top 40 individually to score 70 points. Defending champion Middlebury scored 111 points to finish second.

Individually, senior Erica Jackey placed fourth, the highest finish in school history. Jackey finished the 6,000-meter course in a season-best time of 21:04.21. Chiara Del Piccolo from Williams won the individual championship with a time of 20:52.08.

Washington freshman Lucy Cheadle ran a season-best time of 21:28.59 to finish 20th, while sophomore Sarah Fisher and senior Molly Wawrzyniak followed in 22nd and 23rd with season-best times of 21:31.34 and 21:31.55, respectively. Senior Elizabeth Phillips rounded out the Washington scoring with a season-best time of 21:48.79, which placed her in 40th overall.
