2012 Highlights

Big first for Johns Hopkins – Johns Hopkins totaled 153 points to capture its first NCAA Division III Women's Cross Country Championships team title November 17 at the LaVerne Gibson Championship Course in Terre Haute, Indiana. The title is the first women's national championship in any sport in Johns Hopkins history, and first Division III title since men's swimming and diving in 1979.

"I'm just so proud of them," head coach Bobby Van Allen said. "We've had our ups and downs this season, but we came together and made it exciting and it worked. Everybody supported each other throughout the entire year and I think that was really the biggest difference."

Hopkins defeated runner-up Wartburg by 63 points, the largest margin of victory in the championships since 2002. Claremont-Mudd-Scripps finished third with 233 points.

Three Blue Jays placed in the top 35 to achieve All-America status, as freshman Hannah Oneda finished 10th, junior Holly Clarke finished 25th and senior Annie Monagle earned 32nd. Clarke is the first two-time All-American in program history.

"The goal was to win nationals from the beginning," Oneda said. "I was relieved to earn All-America and I was excited to know that we had achieved our goal."

The Blue Jays advanced to the front of the pack from the outset of the race. Oneda, Clarke and Monagle sat comfortably in the lead through the first mile, while Johns Hopkins' four-through-seven runners were packed in the top 50.

"[The plan] was smart, then heart," Monagle said. "We broke up the race into two parts: we ran smart in the first half and then with heart in the second half."

The Blue Jays runners found that their previous experience on the championship course at the pre-national meet earlier in the season worked to their advantage, as each runner improved on their pre-national time.

"We knew where the hills were and we knew where to go," Clarke said. "That last stretch was definitely the hardest, but that's where we had to kick and we knew what we had to do."

Wisconsin-Oshkosh's Christy Cazzola took the individual crown, covering the 6,000 meters in 20:53.3, while Ohio Northern's Alison Steinbrunner (21:08.9) and Amherst's Keri Lambert (21:13.0) rounded out the top three. Cazzola is the third Wisconsin-Oshkosh competitor to claim the individual championship.
