2012 Highlights

Grand Valley State edges Augustana (South Dakota) for second title: Grand Valley State captured its second Division II Women's Cross Country Championships team title November 17 at Missouri Southern State's Robert W. Plaster Sports Complex.

Three Lakers placed in the top 40, earning All-American honors and leading the team to its second title in three years. It also was the eighth consecutive year the Lakers have placed in the top three.

"This was an amazing victory for our program," head coach Jerry Baltes said. "There are so many people that committed so much to this championship. I am thankful for everyone's hard work.

"I am so proud of this team and how they committed to each other and the common goal of becoming the best team on the day when it mattered most"

Grand Valley State scored 101 points, just three points ahead of the 2011 champion, Augustana (South Dakota), and eight points ahead of Adams State. Western State (172) and Cal State Chico (200) rounded out the top five teams.

Senior Alicia Nelson became Adams State's fourth individual champion with a new championships-record time of 20:03.3 for 6,000 meters. She finished more than 12 seconds ahead of runner-up Susan Tanui of Alaska Anchorage.

Leading the way for Grand Valley State was freshman Jessica Janecke with a fourth-place finish in a time of 20:23.2. Sophomore Allyson Winchester placed sixth at 20:29.0.

Sophomore Hannah Osborn finished 26th with a career personal-best time of 21:08.7, while classmate Madie Rodts ran a time of 21:25.8 to place 42nd. Junior Courtney Brewis capped off the top five runners for the Lakers with a time of 21:36.5, finishing 51st.
