Highlights

Maryland rallies past North Carolina in OT, captures its eighth national championship: Maryland (19-4) came back from a two-goal deficit with less than four minutes remaining in regulation to top North Carolina, 3-2, in overtime for its eighth national title.

Freshman Katie Gerzabek scored the first Terrapin goal in the 67th minute, senior Jemma Buckley ripped in the equalizer with no time on the clock in regulation, and sophomore Jill Witmer netted the game-winner in the 81st minute for the Terps' fifth NCAA crown in seven years (2005, 2006, 2008, 2010, 2011).

Since the NCAA began seeding the top four teams in the tournament in 2002, the Terps are the first unseeded team to win a title. They beat the top three teams (Syracuse, Old Dominion, North Carolina) in order, en route to their repeat crown.

"Can't say enough what an amazing team North Carolina (23-2) is and they have been all year," head coach Missy Meharg said. "They were so far above us in the first half and at halftime, we just spoke about competing and playing with intangibles. We couldn't be more proud of the Maryland team."

The Tar Heels took a 1-0 lead in the ninth minute when Kelsey Kolojchick found Elizabeth Stephens by the post for the deflection. They would take that one-goal lead into the break.

North Carolina added its second goal with 7:57 left in the game when Kolojchick brought it up and again found Stephens around the cage for the tip-in.

Meharg pulled goalkeeper Melissa Vassalotti with 4:28 left in the game and the Terps down by two. Forty-two seconds later, Gerzabek tipped in a long pass from the corner by junior Harriet Tibble to cut the Heels' lead to 2-1.

With 17 seconds to play, the Terrapins were awarded their third penalty corner of the game. Janessa Pope inserted on the play, Tibble stopped, and Buckley drilled in the equalizer with no time left on the clock to send the game to overtime for the second consecutive year.

In the 81st minute, Witmer checked in after a quick break with a fresh pair of legs. She instantly took the ball, streaked down the sideline and crossed across to the other side of the circle. She wound up and took a hard shot that flew into the net behind North Carolina goalkeeper Sassi Ammer.

Vassalotti tied her career-high eight saves in the win and Ammer had one. North Carolina outshot the Terps, 13-6, and had six penalty corners to Maryland's five.

Buckley, Megan Frazer, Tibble and Witmer were all named to the NCAA All-Tournament Team.

This marked the Terps' 11th appearance in the NCAA finals and fifth time Maryland and North Carolina had met in the NCAA title game, including the last three consecutive years.

"Karen (Shelton) is just a dynamic coach," Meharg said. "The way those women compete. It's a history. One thing I have found is they're very systematic. They don't make a lot of mistakes. So for us to get on the board against that backfield was really a miracle. The rivalry's there. It's fun. Without North Carolina, Maryland could never be doing what we're doing."

North Carolina leads the overall series, 33-24, but Maryland has won four of the last five.

"Today's game for me was better than Friday's (semifinal) game because we play a similar style," Shelton said. "I like the way both teams move the ball. And it's more of a chess match playing the University of Maryland than it is playing some other teams. I think playing them in the ACC, you don't want it to become a bitter, nasty rivalry because we see them so much. That's negative energy."

Maryland's Buckley, who scored the Terrapins' key goal that tied the game at the end of regulation, said the team tries not to focus too much on the hoopla.

"I think there's a rivalry there," Buckley said. "But we do have to keep a level head and treat it as any other game. I think we try to concentrate more on ourselves."

Highlights

West Chester wins first NCAA national title; Golden Rams scored two goals in the first half to secure the win: West Chester battled past Massachusetts-Lowell to a 2-1 victory Nov. 13, winning its first NCAA championship.

Massachusetts-Lowell started the game by putting two of three shots on target and earning one corner opportunity in the first 5:30 of the contest. However, the Golden Rams would be the first to strike at the 6:16 mark of the half. Kayla Gluchowski set up the West Chester goal by sending a cross into the circle where Nicole Fiorilla ripped a shot for a 1-0 lead.

West Chester kept the pressure on, earning two penalty corners, which ultimately led to their second goal of the game. Senior captain Brynn Adams punched in the second goal on the second corner attempt to give the Golden a 2-0 edge with 19:46 to play in the first half.

Neither team scored for the remainder of the half as West Chester marched into halftime with a 2-0 lead. Shots in the first half were in favor of the Golden Rams, 12-10, and so were penalty corners, 7-4.

The Golden Rams came out in the second half looking to build on their two-goal lead, firing eight shots to Massachusetts-Lowell's two, but it was the River Hawks who made the most of their opportunities.

Massachusetts-Lowell was awarded a penalty corner around the 56th minute, which set up a shot by Sarah Wilcox that was blocked by a West Chester defender. Wilcox recovered the ball and drove a pass to Ali Ferraro who buried a shot into the upper right corner for a goal, cutting the West Chester lead to one.

A little over three minutes of play would go by before West Chester's Gluchowski was given a yellow card, forcing the Golden Rams to play with one fewer player. The next five minute stretch saw four River Hawk shots and a penalty corner opportunity, none of which produced a score.

Following a Massachusetts-Lowell timeout with 4:06 remaining, the River Hawks pulled their goalie, opting for an extra field player. Less than a minute later Massachusetts-Lowell's Kayla Littig received a yellow card, forcing the River Hawks to return their goalie to net and play with one fewer body.

"We are thrilled to win our first national championship at the Division II level. These kids worked hard every day since March for this. We talked before the game that there were only six teams in the country that have this chance at a national championship," West Chester head coach Amy Cohen said.

Both goalies were superb as both offenses put them to the test. Massachusetts-Lowell's Melanie Hopkins made 10 saves in 69:02 of action, while West Chester's Kristin Arnold denied 12 shots in a full 70 minutes of play.

Highlights

TCNJ captures 11th national title, scores twice off penalty corners for first title since 1999: All season long The College of New Jersey meticulously practiced penalty corners. All that effort paid off in the ultimate prize as the Lions scored a pair of goals off penalty corners as they captured the program's 10th NCAA Division III Championship with a 3-1 win against Middlebury on Nov. 20.

It was TCNJ's 11th title overall with the first of those predating the NCAA tournament.

The championship was the first for the Lions since 1999. They finished the year riding a 14-game win streak and a final mark of 24-2. TCNJ ranks first in all of Division III in competing in 71 national championship games, winning 38 national titles overall.

It was penalty corners that proved to be the difference as the Lions got the game-winning goal when freshman Erin Waller broke a 1-1 tie with 23:55 remaining in the game as she knocked home a feed from junior Camille Passucci from the top of the circle.

TCNJ's defense then protected that lead as Shannon Syciarz made a tough save on a turnaround shot attempt by Charlotte Gardiner minutes later and then freshman Lauren Pigott broke up a two-on-one for the Panthers.

The combination of Passucci to Waller added an insurance goal with 5:46 left in the game as Waller scored her second of the game off a penalty corner with Passucci again setting up the score.

"This team has a great feel of what a national championship team is made of, and they have played championship smart the whole tournament," said head coach Sharon Pfluger, who guided the Lions to their eighth 20-win season.

Syciarz was honored as the tournament's most outstanding player as she finished with a .974 save percentage and a 0.25 goals-against-average with three shutouts. She was joined on the all-tournament team by Passucci, Kathleen Notos and senior Alex Okuniewicz.

In the opening half, the Lions nearly got on the board a shade under 10 minutes in as Notos had a shot clank off the post.

Middlebury countered with three consecutive quality chances with the first coming off the stick of Lauren Greer. Syciarz stepped out to make a save on a penalty corner and on the second one Syciarz sprawled out to deny Greer from close range.

TCNJ junior Meredith Jeffries came up with a big play on the third Panther chance recording a defensive save on a scoring bid by Hannah Clarke.

Notos continued her tremendous tournament as she gave TCNJ the lead with 12:01 remaining in the opening half tipping in a centering pass from Waller. That play originally started with a penalty corner. The goal was Notos' eighth of the season, with five of them coming in the NCAA tournament.

Syciarz was then tested as she made a highlight-reel save on Greer. Greer came into the circle all alone and Syciarz waited her out forcing her toward the far post. The Panther used her speed to create a shooting lane and fired off a shot, but Syciarz dove and made the save.

The Panthers quickly got the equalizer in the second half as Clarke directed in a shot 2:24 into the period. That goal was the first the Lions allowed in the tournament and the first in more than five games, but it wasn't enough for the Panthers.

"You just can't describe it," Syciarz said. "It's just something you have to experience to feel!"
