Highlights

Princeton defeats North Carolina to capture first national title in program history: For the first time in program history, Princeton won the NCAA Division I championship in a comeback 3-2 victory against North Carolina November 18. Princeton topped the six-time national champions to take the battle between the top two teams in the nation.

Princeton won the game off a penalty stroke in the 60th minute from Amanda Bird.

The opening minutes of the match were quick paced, as both sides looked to possess the ball, but it was North Carolina that took the initial advantage.

The Tar Heels earned consecutive penalty corners in the third and fourth minutes, but Princeton managed to deflect their shot attempts. Before the Tigers were able to fire off a shot of their own, North Carolina was awarded another series of corners. On North Carolina's fourth corner of the match, Charlotte Craddock sent in the opening goal at 11:26.

Down 1-0, Princeton had an offensive surge and moved the ball into the Tar Heel circle. On a drive outside the cage, Kathleen Sharkey was fouled and the Tigers set up their first penalty corner of the game. Julia Reinprecht fed the ball to Katie Reinprecht and Sharkey was there to slam in the tying goal at 17:01.

With the score tied at one, the second half opened similarly to the first as both sides exchanged possession, but were unable to convert on penalty corners.

The Tigers saw one of their best chances to take the lead in the 44th minute off a Kelsey Byrne drive down the right flank. She found Allison Evans open in the circle, but her point-blank shot was stopped by North Carolina's goalie Sassi Ammer.

On the Tar Heels' ensuing drive, Craddock connected with an open Katie Plyler on the far post to tip in the go-ahead goal 2-1 at 46:03.

With 17 minutes to play, Princeton set up another opportunity in front of the Tar Heel goal. Sydney Kirby dished the ball to Evans from the left side, but Evans was unable to redirect the ball into the cage.

After two close calls, Evans finally was there to put in a goal in the 57th minute. Kirby fed the ball to Sharkey on the right side. She passed it back to Kirby and her first attempt was deflected off Ammer's pads. The ball bounced to the left side and Evans was there to tap in the tying goal.

At 59:52, Michelle Cesan dribbled the ball into the right side of the circle. Cesan was tackled to the right of the cage and the Tigers were awarded a penalty stroke. Junior Bird went to the chalk mark and sailed it in on the right side to give Princeton a 3-2 lead. The stroke was the first of the season for her, and the Tigers conclude the year going a perfect 4-for-4 on strokes.

With less than a minute to play, North Carolina took a final penalty corner, and the ball was sent in high and wide.

North Carolina held a 13-11 shot shot advantage, but Princeton had a 10-9 differential on shots on goal.

Highlights

West Chester blanks Massachusetts-Lowell for second consecutive national title: For the second year in a row, the NCAA championship came down to West Chester against Massachusetts-Lowell, and the outcome was the same.

Defending national champion West Chester jumped out to an early lead and held it, defeating Massachusetts-Lowell, 5-0, November 11.

The margin of victory is the largest in the national championship since 2002.

West Chester jumped on top early with a pair of goals in the first six minutes of the contest. Senior Kayla Gluchowski got the Golden Rams on the board first, scoring just two minutes into play off an assist from Megan Callanan. The goal was Gluchowski's 13th of the season.

Before Massachusetts-Lowell could strike back, junior Kelsi Lykens scored an unassisted goal in the sixth minute, giving the Golden Rams a 2-0 lead.

"I knew that if we could maintain possession and keep the ball on the outside of the field, that we would be successful today," West Chester head coach Amy Cohen said. "The team did a great job of executing the game plan limiting Lowell's opportunities."

West Chester continued to put pressure on the River Hawks back line through the first half. Ten minutes after Lykens' goal, freshman Alexis Versak tipped in junior Stef Pirri's shot attempt, pushing the lead to 3-0.

As first-half play came to a close, Massachusetts-Lowell's Bianca Jones got a penalty corner, but was unable to find the back of the cage.

Just one minute into the second half, senior Michele Schrift ripped a shot home to push the lead to 4-0. The goal was Schrift's 24th for the season.

Sophomore Kelsey Cheek closed out the scoring in the 56th minute, finishing off a pass from Callanan, who posted a pair of assists on the day.

Massachusetts-Lowell got a couple of good scoring opportunities in the closing minutes, but was not able to capitalize.

Senior Kristin Arnold played the first 65 minutes of the game, making a pair of saves in goal and registering her 20th win of the season. Fellow senior Gabby Panasiewicz played the remainder of the game and made one save.

"Both championships are different. They are so unique," Arnold stated afterwards when asked to compare last year's title with this year's crown. "They both mean a lot. I think we took the hardest route possible to get here this year. We had to play a tough Indiana (Pennsylvania) team in the quarterfinals and then play Shippensburg in the semifinals.

"Lowell is a competitive team. I can't say that I felt comfortable until about 10 minutes left in the second half. I couldn't be happier for my teammates. It is such a joyful feeling, that I don't think I can put it into words."

Massachusetts-Lowell goalkeeper Melanie Hopkins made four saves in a losing effort.

Highlights

Freshman Park's pair of goals lead Tufts past Montclair State for NCAA title: First-year Hannah Park scored twice as Tufts won, 2-1, against Montclair State on November 18 to capture the 2012 NCAA Division III championship at William Smith's Mc-Cooey Field. It's the first NCAA women's team title in Tufts history.

Park's pair of first-half goals helped Tufts overcome a 1-0 deficit in the game. She also had an assist in the team's 2-0 semifinal win against DePauw and was named the tournament's Most Outstanding Player. First-year players scored all four goals and had two of the team's three assists in Tufts' last two games.

"This is definitely a dream come true," Park said. "I remember this summer thinking how awesome it would be just to make it to the national championship."

The Red Hawks (22-2) opened the scoring, earning a penalty corner in the 11th minute. Junior Sierra Rauchbach sent a cross from the left side of the cage to senior Frances Schaefer on the right side. Her first attempt was turned back by Tufts goalie Brianna Keenan, but Schaefer collected her own rebound and scored her 18th goal of the year.

In the 16th minute, the Jumbos (19-2) pulled even on a penalty corner of their own. They inserted the ball to the top of the circle where Dakota Sikes-Keilp sent up a shot that senior Megan Bosland kicked to her right. The ricochet landed on the Park's stick. She fired it home for her fourth goal of the season.

Tufts took the lead with 6:34 left in the opening half. First-year Alexandra Jamison sent a pass from outside the circle into the middle, where Park redirected it for her second goal of the afternoon.

The Red Hawks had a chance to pull even just before halftime. On a scramble in front of the Jumbo goal, Keenan saved a shot from her left. The rebound was stopped by senior Rachel Gerhardt's defensive save, but the third Montclair State attempt was kept out of the goal by a body ball, resulting in a penalty stroke. With 4:24 left in the half, junior Stephanie Lewis missed the shot wide left.

In the second half, Montclair State had several scoring opportunities early, earning four corners in the first 11 minutes. The Red Hawks briefly celebrated what they thought was a game-tying goal off a corner, but one of the Montclair State players entered the circle too early and the goal was waived off.

In the final 24 minutes, the Jumbos limited the Red Hawks to just a single shot. Keenan earned the win with five saves. Bosland made four stops for the Red Hawks.

Montclair State had a 12-11 edge in shots and an 8-7 advantage in corners.
