Highlights

PERFECTION: Massachusetts-Lowell Field Hockey Captures 2010 National Championship, Completes 24-0 Season: After falling in the championship game for each of the past three years, the Massachusetts-Lowell River Hawks posted a 1-0 victory over Shippensburg on Dec. 4 at the Division II National Championships Festival in Louisville, Ky., to claim the field hockey crown.

The game's only goal came at the 22:46 mark of the first half when freshman forward Rachel McCarthy sent in a penalty corner to senior forward Sammy Macy, who found senior midfielder Liz Day open inside the circle. Day hammered a line drive past Shippensburg goalie Ciarra Delost into the right-hand corner of the cage.

"After losing in the championship game the last three years, we poured our hearts out to each other in a team meeting last night," senior forward Katie Enaire said. "We knew we had what it takes to get it done and we did. We are all so excited, and to finish our career like this is just the best feeling in the world."

Shippensburg pressured Massachusetts-Lowell the entire game, forcing River Hawk freshman goalie Melanie Hopkins into making six saves. The Raiders took 13 shots to only three for the River Hawks but were not able to get any past Hopkins, who only allowed eight goals all season.

Shippensburg set a school record with 21 victories on the season against only two losses. It also was the first time the Raiders had ever reached the NCAA championship game after falling in the semifinals in their four previous appearances.
