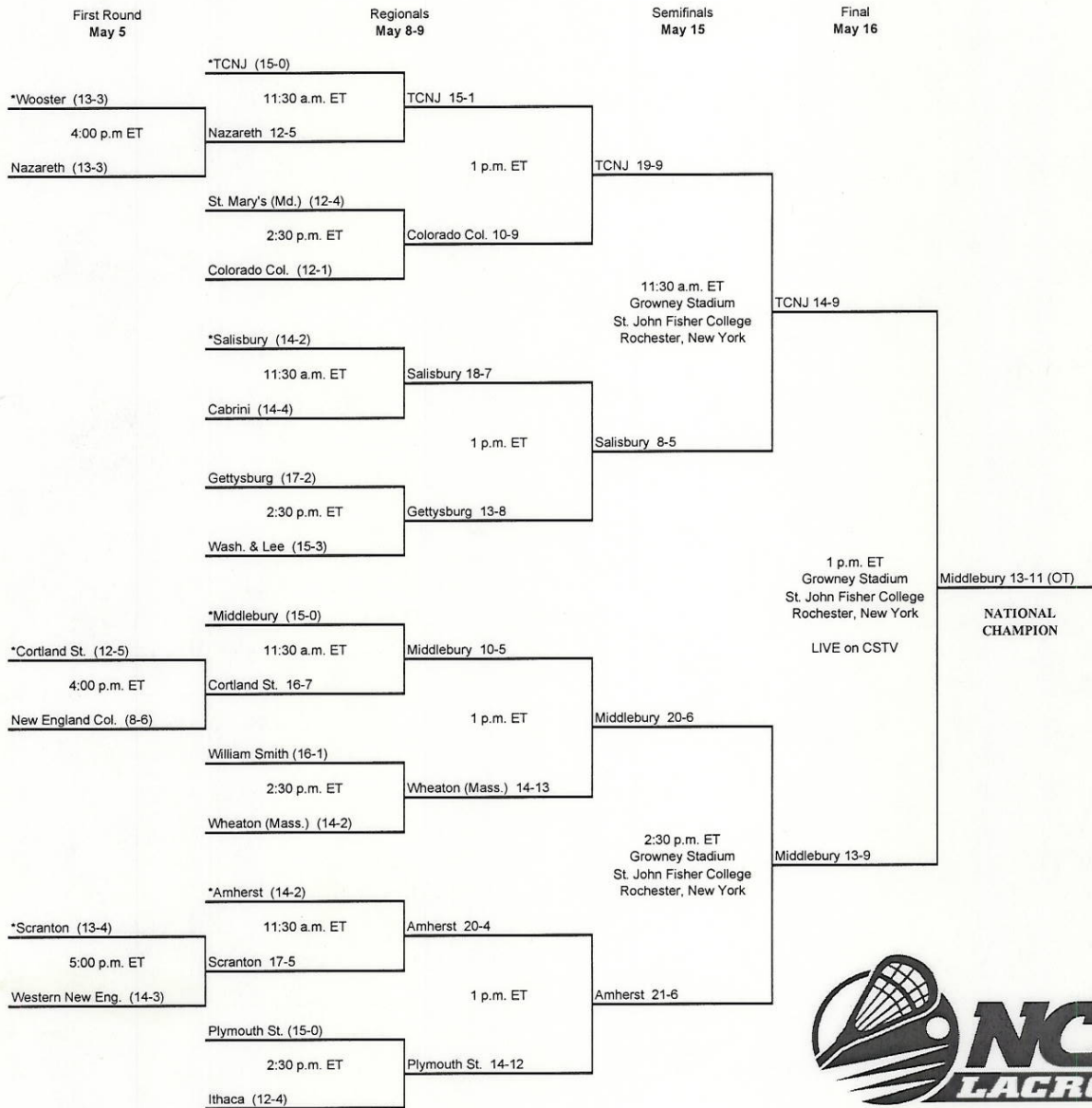
2003 NCAA Division III Women's LACROSSE CHAMPIONSHIP

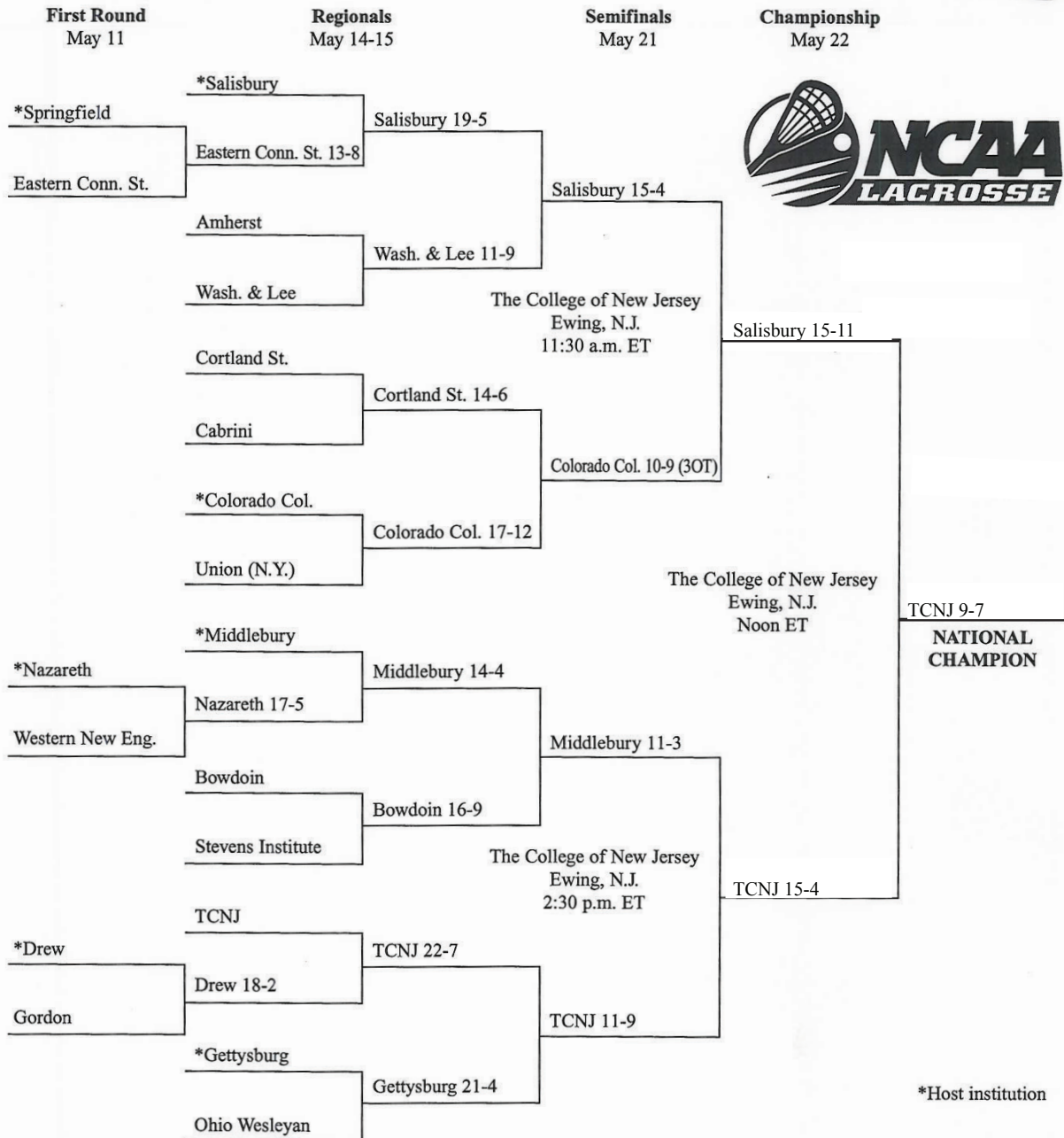
