Individual Records

The format of the game changed in 2001, with scoring for each game moving from 15 points to 30 points. In reflection of this change, category leaders under the new scoring format are separated in order to not eliminate the achievements of those student-athletes who played under the previous format.

Official NCAA volleyball records began with the 1981 season and are based on information submitted to the NCAA statistics service by institutions participating in the statistics rankings. In statistical rankings, the rounding of percentages and/or averages may indicate ties where none exist. In these cases, the numerical order of the rankings is accurate.

Information on blocking has not been included in the following records due to the fact that there appears to be a significant variance in the methods by which blocking statistics were kept during the 1980s. Research continues to determine a standard by which to measure blocking statistics for NCAA record-keeping purposes.

Single-match record lists are not divided by the number of games in a match. If the three-game record is not among the listed performances, it is just indicated below. Performances from two-game matches are not included in single-match records.

Official career records include players whose career statistics were recorded during the era of official NCAA play.

An "M" located after a number under a "games played" column indicates the number of matches played, as the number of games is unavailable.

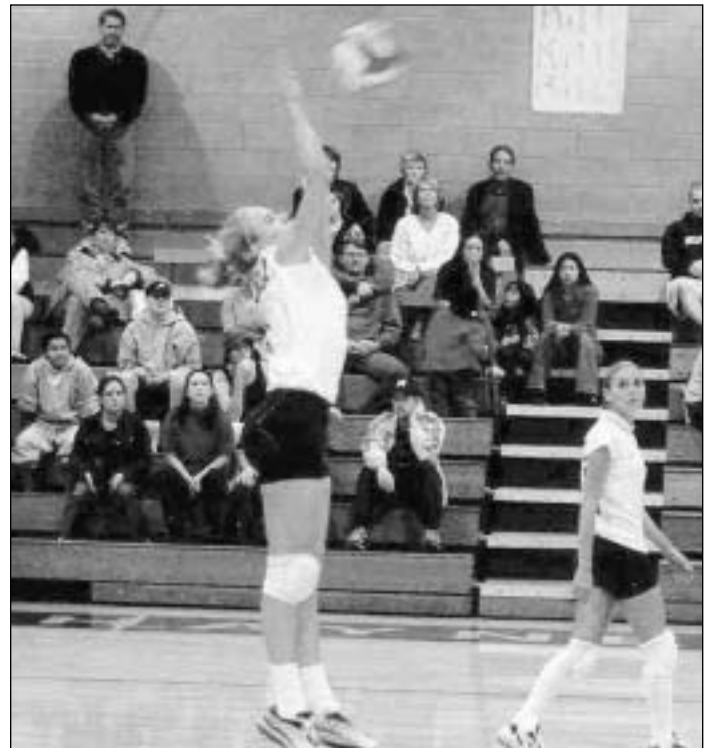

Team Records

The format of the game changed in 2001, with scoring for each game moving from 15 points to 30 points. In reflection of this change, category leaders under the new scoring format are separated in order to not eliminate the achievements of those student-athletes who played under the previous format.

Official NCAA volleyball records began with the 1981 season and are based on information submitted to the NCAA statistics service by institutions participating in the statistics rankings. In statistical rankings, the rounding of percentages and/or averages may indicate ties where none exist. In these cases, the numerical order of the rankings is accurate.

Information on blocking has not been included in the following records due to the fact that there appears to be a significant variance in the methods by which blocking statistics were kept during the 1980s. Research continues to determine a standard by which to measure blocking statistics for NCAA record-keeping purposes.
