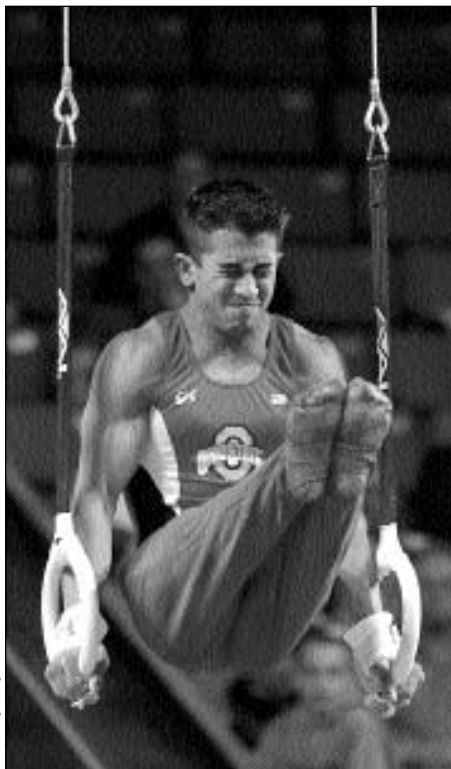

### Highlights

**Sooner or Later, Oklahoma Gets the Win:** Oklahoma's Daniel Furney posted a strong performance to help the host Sooners defeat Ohio State by less than a point.

The Sooners were upset by the Buckeyes last year. The title is Oklahoma's fourth overall and first since 1991.

In the individual events, Minnesota's Clay Strother repeated as champion on the pommel horse and floor exercise.
