2002 Championships

Highlights

Alabama proved unstoppable on its home floor. The Crimson Tide edged rival Georgia for its fourth overall title and third when hosting the championships.

Despite a last-minute injury to Raegan Tomasek, Alabama rose to the challenge behind a dominating Andree' Pickens, who posted three 9.95 scores on the night.

Meanwhile, Cory Fritzinger rallied Georgia to its second consecutive runner-up finish.

UCLA's Jamie Dantzscher won the all-around title and then claimed the vault and floor events. Pickens grabbed second in the all-around and first in the uneven bars. Elise Ray won the beam title for Michigan.
