Highlights

Augsburg outscores Wisconsin-La Crosse in wrestling: Riding out a strong showing in the early session on March 6, Augsburg its 11th NCAA Division III Wrestling team title before the final session at the U.S. Cellular Center in Cedar Rapids.

Yet the mix of top seeds, defending titlists out to repeat and unseeded wrestlers who earned their way to the finals provided an exciting final evening.

Augsburg's team victory kept alive the stranglehold that the Auggies and rival Wartburg have on the championship - they are the only two teams to win the team title since 1994.

While Augsburg is the 2009-10 team champion, all three of the Auggies who reached the finals dropped their title matches, marking only the third time in championship history the team champion did not have an individual winner. Augsburg finished with 110.5.

Both Augsburg and Wisconsin-La Crosse sent three wrestlers to the final round.

Wisconsin-La Crosse trailed Augsburg by 22 points entering the last session, but the Eagles closed the final margin dramatically, with all three finalists, Beбето Yewah (133), Michael Schmitz (174) and Dan Laurent (285) capturing individual titles. The Eagles picked up plenty of team points late to end with 100.5 points. Wisconsin-La Crosse also finished in second place in 2006 and 2008.

Wartburg, the team champion of the last two seasons, finished third with 83.5 points. Wartburg and Coe (76 points) each brought the maximum 10 wrestlers to the championship meet.

"There are a couple of matches that we'd like to have back," said Coe head coach John Oostendorp. "We've been top four and top five, and, hopefully, we can keep working towards our goal."

Delaware Valley took fifth with 50.5 points. Ithaca was sixth at 41.
